SECTION 1 - DEFINITION OF TERMS

For the purposes of this Tariff, RCN Telecom Services of Pennsylvania, Inc. d/b/a RCN of Pennsylvania concurs with the definitions contained in Title 52-PA Code, relating to customer service classifications.

Authorization Code: A numerical code, one or more of which may be assigned to a Customer to enable identification of individual users or groups of users on an account and to allocate costs of service accordingly. Authorization Codes are the sole property of the Company, and no Customer shall have any property or other right or interest in the use of any particular Authorization Code.

Automatic Numbering Identification (ANI): A type of signaling provided by a local exchange telephone company which automatically identifies the local exchange line from which a call originates.

Bill to Third Party: The term "Bill to Third Party" denotes a billing arrangement by which a call may be charged to an authorized station as determined by the Company other than the station originating the call or the station where the call is terminated.

Billed Party: The person or entity responsible for payment of the Company's service. The Billed Party is the Customer associated with the Authorization Code used to place the call, with the following exceptions:

- (a) In the case of a calling card or credit card call, the Billed Party is the party assigned the Authorization Code for the calling card or credit card used by the Users: and
- (b) In the case of a collect or third party call, the Billed Party is the person responsible for the local telephone service at the telephone number that agrees to accept charges for the call.

Called Station: The terminating point of a call.

Calling Card: A card issued by the Company containing such account numbers assigned to its Customer which enables the charges for calls made to be properly billed on a pre-arranged basis.

Calling Station: The originating point of a call.

Collect Call: The term "Collect Call" denotes a billing arrangement by which the charge for a call may be reversed provided the charge is accepted at the called station. A collect call may be billed to a calling card or third party number.

Company: RCN Telecom Services of Pennsylvania, Inc. or "RCN".

Customer Dialed Calling Card Station: Customer Dialed Calling Card Station is a calling card call which does note require intervention by an attended operator position to complete.

Customer Dialed 1+: Customer Dialed 1+ denotes that situation where the customer dials "1" and continues to dial the called station.

Customer Dialed 0+: Customer Dialed 0+ denotes that situation where the customer dials the appropriate operator code and continues to dial called station.

Debit Card: A calling card issued by the Company in return for prepayment of an amount certain by the Customer. The Customer uses a Personal Identification Number (PIN) associated with the card to make calls which are charged against the prepayment amount until it is exhausted.

Message Telecommunications Service: Message Telecommunications Service (MTS) is that of furnishing facilities or telecommunications between stations in accordance with the regulations and price schedules specified in this tariff.

Holidays: New Year's Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Additional days may be included on a promotional basis.

Off Net Service: A resale product sold to customers in areas where the Company cannot originate via its leased facilities.

On Net Service: Service provided to customers in areas where the Company has network origination capabilities.

SECTION 1 - DEFINITION OF TERMS (cont'd)

Operator Dialed Surcharge: Operator Dialed Surcharge applies a surcharge to Operator Station and Person-to-Person rated calls when the customer has the capability of dialing all the digits necessary to complete a call, but elects to dial only the appropriate operator code and requires prompting by the operator system to dial the called station or requests the operator to dial the called station. The surcharge applies in addition to any applicable service charges. The surcharge does not apply to: calls where a customer cannot otherwise dial the call, due to defective equipment or trouble on the Company's Network; calls in which a Company operator places a call for a calling party who identifies himself / herself as being unable to dial the call because of his / her handicap calls for which the Company does not have the technical capability to impose the surcharge; and calling card calls.

Operator Dialed 0-: Operator Dialed 0- denotes that situation where the customer dials only the appropriate operator code and then requests the operator to dial the called station.

Operator Station: Operator Station denotes calls that are completed with the assistance of a Company operator, except as specified for the Dial Station, Customer Dialed Calling Card Station, Person-to-Person, and Real Time Rated classes of service. Operator Station prices apply to calls which are billed to a different telephone number (e.g., collect, bill to a third number) or a calling card.

Person-to-Person: The term "Person-to-Person" denotes that service where the person originating the call specifies to the Company operator a particular person to be reached, a particular mobile station to be reached through a miscellaneous common carrier attendant, or a particular station, department, or office to be reached through a Centrex or PBX attendant. When, after the station, miscellaneous common carrier mobile radio system, Centrex, or PBX called has been reached and while the connection remains established, the person originating the call requests or agrees to talk to any person other than the person specified, or to any other person or mobile station to be reached through a miscellaneous common carrier attendant, or to any other station, department or office to be reached through a Centrex or PBX attendant, the classification of the call When the person originating the call wishes remains Person-to-Person. arrangements made in advance with a particular party or station for the establishment of a connection at a specified time (appointment call) the call is classified as Person-to-Person.

SECTION 1 - DEFINITION OF TERMS (cont'd)

Real Time Rated: Real Time Rated calls are those that originate and are paid for at public or semi-public telephones and calls for which the Company furnishes time and / or charge information.

Station: The term "station" denotes the network control signaling unit and any other equipment which enables a customer to establish communications and to effect communications through such connections.

Telecommunications: The transmission of voice communications or, subject to the transmission capabilities of the service, the transmission of data, facsimile, signaling, metering, or any other form of intelligence.

Universal Range: Limitation of a Customer's ability to place calls to selected Area Codes through the placement of restrictions on a Customer's 1+ and calling card access to the network. Such limitations may be imposed by only specific request of Customers on their own lines or cards.

User: A Customer, or any person or entity which makes use of services provided to a Customer under this tariff.

Verified Account Code: A numerical code, one or more of which are available to a Customer to enable identification of individual users or groups of users on an account and to allocate costs of service accordingly. Account codes are verified against a predefined list of codes maintained by the Company.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. <u>Description of Service</u>

1. <u>Basic Service Offering:</u> The Company offers and provides the resale of message toll services to residential and business customers. Service is available on a full time basis, twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week.

B. <u>Service Availability</u>

- 1. The Company offers service to all those within its service area, who desire to purchase service from the Company consistent with all provisions of this Tariff. Customers or subscribers interested in the Company's services may be required to file a service application with the Company which will fully identify the customer and all services requested.
- .2. Service is offered subject to the Company's ability to technically provide the service requested and subject to the availability of the necessary facilities and/or equipment.

C. <u>Classes of Service</u>

Service is offered on a Dial Station, Operator Station, Person-to-Person, and Real Time Rated basis. Charges for messages within these classes of service are based upon the day-of-week and the time-of-day that each initial period or additional minute begins as shown in Section 4.

1. <u>Dial Station</u>

This category of service applies in connection with calls made from other than public or semi-public telephones where the person originating the call dials the telephone number desired and the call is completed without the assistance of a Company operator or when an operator is required only to: 1) record the originating telephone number where no automatic recording equipment is available; 2) reach the called telephone number where facilities are not available for dial completion; 3) establish a dialed connection where the customer has been unable to do so, re-establish a call which has been interrupted after the called number has been reached; and 4) handle calls in the case of station sets furnished for the physically disabled who are unable to dial, and the calling party does not specify a particular person to be reached, nor a particular extension station line, department or office to be reached through a PBX attendant, but only gives the Company operator the telephone number of the desired exchange access line, PBX system or PBX extension station line, which is reached directly rather than through a PBX attendant.

C. <u>Classes of Service (cont'd)</u>

- 2. <u>Operator Station:</u> Operator Station surcharges apply when calls are completed with the assistance of a Company operator, except as specified for the Dial Station, Person-to-Person, and Real Time Rated classes of service. Operator Station surcharges apply to calls which are billed to a different telephone number (e.g., collect, or bill to a third number).
- 3. <u>Person-to-Person:</u> Person-to-Person prices apply when the person originating the call specifies the particular party to be reached by the Company operator, except Person-to-Person calls rated on a real time basis. The specified party may be a person, or a station, department, extension or office through a PBX attendant.

Customers may use services and facilities provided under this tariff to obtain access to services offered by other service providers. The Company is responsible under this tariff only for the services and facilities provided hereunder, and it assumes no responsibility for any service provided by any other entity that purchases access to the Company's network in order to originate or terminate its own services, or to communicate with its own customers.

4. <u>Real Time Rated-Operator Station/Person-to-Person:</u> Real Time Rated prices apply to the following calls: calls originated and paid for at public and semi-public telephones; calls for which the Company furnishes time and/or charges.

D. <u>Nonrecurring Charges</u>

- 1. Customer, subscriber or end user will be billed and is responsible for payment of applicable local, state and federal taxes assessed in conjunction with the services used, as well as all stated charges for the services provided by the Company on behalf of the customer.
- 2. The Company reserves the right to examine the credit record of all service applicants and to require a service deposit when determined to be necessary to assure future payment. Security Deposits required will be equal to not more than two (2) moths estimated usage as computed by the Company and will in all respects be consistent with Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code Subchapter 64.31 - 64.41.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (cont'd)

E. <u>Billing Disputes</u>

- 1. Billing disputes shall be processed by the Company or its billing agent(s) consistent with Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code Chapter 64.
- 2. Customers unsatisfied with the Company's handling of a dispute may contact the Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services.

F. <u>Cancellation or Termination of Service</u>

- 1. The Customer may cancel service upon written notice to the Company.
- 2. The Company may terminate service to a customer or subscriber for nonpayment of undisputed charges or other violation of this tariff or provision of law upon 10 days' written notice to the customer without incurring any liability for damages due to loss of telephone service to the subscriber.

G. Liability and Interconnections

- 1. Except as stated in this section 2.G, the Company shall have no liability for damages of any kind arising out of or related to events, acts, rights or privileges contemplated in this tariff.
- 2. The Company is not liable for any act or omission of any other entity furnishing to the customer facilities, equipment, or services used with the Company's services. Nor shall the Company be liable for any damages or losses due to the failure of Customer-provided equipment, facilities or services. Company is not liable for any act or omission of any other company or companies furnishing a portion of the service. No agents or employees of connecting, concurring or other participating carriers or companies shall be deemed to be agents or employees of the Company without written authorization.
- 3. The Company shall not be liable for any failure of performance hereunder due to causes beyond its control, including but not limited to acts of God, fires, flood or other catastrophes; any law, order, regulation, directive, action or request of the United States Government, or any other government, including state and local governments having jurisdiction over the Company, or of any department, agency, commission, bureau, corporation, or other instrumentality of any one or more of said governments, or of any civil or military authority; national emergencies; insurrections; riots; wars; or other labor difficulties.

- G. Liability and Interconnections (cont'd)
 - 4. Company shall not be liable for and Customer shall indemnify and hold Company harmless from any and all loss claims, demands, suits, or other action or liability whatsoever, whether suffered, made, instituted or asserted by the Customer or by any other party or persons, for any personal injury to, or death of, any person or persons, and for any loss, damage, defacement or destruction of the premises of the Customer or any other property, whether owned by the Customer or by others, caused or claimed to have been caused directly or indirectly by the installation, operation, failure to operate, maintenance, removal, presence, condition, location or use of equipment or wiring provided by Company where such installation, operation, failure to operate, maintenance, condition, location or use is not the direct result of Company's negligence.
 - 5. The liability of the Company for mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors, or defects in transmission shall not exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate recurring charge to the Customer for the period of service during which such events occur. No credit shall be allowed for an interruption of a continuous duration of less than two (2) hours. For purposes of determining service credits, a month shall be deemed to have 720 hours. Any credits will be set off against charges billed during the next month.
 - 6. Company shall be indemnified and held harmless by the Customer against:
 - a. Claims for libel, slander, infringement of copyright or unauthorized use of any trademark trade name or service mark arising out of the material, data, information or other content transmitted over Company's facilities;
 - Claims for patent infringement arising from combining or connecting Company's facilities with apparatus and systems of the Customer; and
 - c. All other claims arising out of any act or omission of the Customer in connection with any service provided by Company.

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (cont'd)

- G. Liability and Interconnections (cont'd)
 - 7. The Company shall not be liable for damages or adjustment, refund, or cancellation of charges unless the Customer has notified the Company in writing, of any dispute concerning charges, or the basis of any claim for damages, within thirty (30) calendar days after the invoice is rendered or a debit is effected by the Company for the call giving rise to such dispute or claim. Any such notice must set forth sufficient facts to provide the Company with a reasonable basis upon which to evaluate the Customer's claim or demands. If notice of a dispute concerning the charges is not received, in writing, within thirty (30) calendar days after an invoice is rendered or a debit is effected, such invoice shall be deemed to be correct, accepted, and binding upon the Customer.
 - 8. Service furnished by the Company may be interconnected with the services or facilities of other carriers or private systems subject to the technical limitations established by Company. Any special interface of equipment or facilities necessary to achieve compatibility between the facilities of Company and other participating carriers shall be provided at the Customer's expense. Service furnished is provided solely by the Company and is not a joint undertaking with others parties.
 - 9. Interconnection between the facilities or services of other carriers shall be under the applicable terms and conditions of the other carrier's tariffs. The Customer is responsible for taking all necessary legal steps for interconnecting Customer provided terminal equipment or communications equipment with Company's facilities. The Customer shall secure all licenses, permits, rights-of-way, and other such arrangements necessary for interconnection.
 - 10. Company reserves the right to disconnect service immediately without incurring liability when necessitated by conditions beyond the Company's control or when the Customer is using the service in violation of either the provisions of this tariff or the laws, rules, regulations, or policies of the jurisdiction of the Calling Station or the Called Station, or the laws of the United States including rules, regulations and policies of the Federal Communications Commission.
 - 11. The Company does not undertake to transmit messages, but offers the use of its facilities when available, and will not be liable for errors in transmission or for failure to establish connections.

- G. <u>Liability and Interconnections (cont'd)</u>
 - 12. Prior written permission from the Company is required before any assignment or transfer. All regulations and conditions contained in this tariff shall apply to all such permitted assignees or transferees, as well as all conditions of service.

H. <u>Use of the Services</u>

- 1. Services may be used for the lawful transmission of communications by the Customer consistent with the provisions of this tariff.
- 2. Service may not be used for any unlawful purpose. The use of the Company's services to make calls which might reasonable be expected to frighten, abuse, torment, or harass another or in such a way as to unreasonably interfere with use by others is prohibited.
- 3. The use of the Company's services without payment for service, as well as any attempt to avoid payment for service by fraudulent means or devices, schemes, false or invalid numbers, or false calling or credit cards, is prohibited.
- 4. The Company's services are available for use twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week.
- 5. Customers of service provided under this tariff may authorize or permit others to use these services, any may resell or share such services subject to the regulations contained in this tariff. The Customer remains responsible to Company for payment of all charges for services used by others pursuant to this paragraph, with or without the Customer's knowledge, and is responsible for notifying the Company immediately of any unauthorized use of services.

- I. <u>Customer Liability for Unauthorized Use of the Network</u>
 - 1. <u>Unauthorized Use of the Network</u>
 - a. Unauthorized use of the Network occurs when: (1) a person or entity that does not have actual, apparent, or implied authority to use the Network, obtains the Company's services provided under this Tariff; or (2) a person or entity that otherwise has actual, apparent, or implied authority to use the Network, makes fraudulent use of the Network to obtain the Company's services provided under this Tariff, or uses specific services that are not authorized.
 - b. The following activities constitute fraudulent use:
 - Using the Network to transmit a message, locate a person, or otherwise give or obtain information, without payment for the service:
 - 2. Using or attempting to use the Network with the intent to avoid payment, either in whole or in part, of any of the Company's tariffed charges by either rearranging, tampering with, or making connections not authorized by this Tariff to any service components used to furnish the Company's services or using fraudulent means or devices, tricks, schemes, false or invalid numbers, false credit devices or electronic devices;
 - 3. Toll Free callers using the Network with the intent of gaining access to a Customer's outbound calling capabilities on an unauthorized basis; and
 - 4. Using fraudulent means or devices, tricks, schemes, false or invalid numbers, false credit devices or electronic devices to defraud or mislead callers.

- I. Customer Liability for Unauthorized Use of the Network (cont'd)
 - 1. <u>Unauthorized Use of the Network (cont'd)</u>
 - c. Customers are advised that use of telecommunications equipment and services, including that provided under this Tariff, carries a risk of various forms of telecommunications fraud (including, but not limited to, toll and PBX fraud perpetrated by Users who gain access to a Customer's facilities, account numbers, security or authorization codes, etc.). Customers should take all necessary steps to restrict access to their facilities, including the equipment and services provided hereunder, and to detect and prevent unauthorized use of the equipment and services provided by the Company under this Tariff.

2. Liability for Unauthorized Use

- a. Except as provided for elsewhere in this Tariff, the Customer is responsible for payment of all charges for services provided under this Tariff furnished to the Customer or User. This responsibility is not changed due to any use, misuse, or abuse, of the Customer's service or Customer-provided equipment by Users or other third parties, the Customer's employees, or the public.
- b. The Customer is responsible for payment of all outbound call charges arising from the calls placed to a Customer's Toll Free Service number, whether or not calls are authorized or fraudulent, where the User gains access to the Customer's outbound calling equipment and services.
- c. The Customer is liable for all costs incurred as a result of unauthorized use of the Network, including service charges and any direct, indirect, special, incidental, reliance, consequential, exemplary or punitive charges.

 - 2. Liability for Unauthorized Use (cont'd)
 - d. The Customer is responsible for payment of any charges related to the suspension and/or termination of service, and any charges for reconnection of service, incurred as a result of unauthorized use of the Network.
 - 3. Liability for Calling Card Fraud
 - a. The Customer is liable for the unauthorized use of the Network obtained through the fraudulent use of a Company Calling Card, provided that the unauthorized use occurs before the Company has been notified.
 - b. The Customer must give the Company notice that unauthorized use of a Company Calling Card has occurred or may occur as a result of loss, theft or other reasons. For the purposes of this section, "notice" occurs when the Company receives a written confirmation that unauthorized use of a Company Calling Card has occurred or may offer as a result of loss, theft or other reasons.
 - c. The Company may, but is not required to, advise the customer of abnormal calling patterns or other possible unauthorized use of Company Calling Cards assigned to the Customer. In addition, the Company may, but is not required to block calls on Company Calling Card authorization codes which the Company believes to be unauthorized or fraudulent.

- I. Customer Liability for Unauthorized Use of the Network (cont'd)
 - 4. Liability for Credit Card Fraud
 - a. The Customer is liable for the unauthorized use of the Network obtained through the fraudulent use of a Credit Card, provided: (1) the Credit Card is an accepted credit card, and (2) the unauthorized use occurs before the Company has been notified.

An accepted credit card is any credit card that a cardholder has requested or applied for and received, or has signed, used, or authorized another person to use to obtain credit. Any credit card issued as a renewel or substitute in accordance with this paragraph is an accepted credit card when received by the cardholder.

- b. The liability of the Customer for unauthorized use of the Network by Credit Card fraud will not exceed the lesser of \$50 or the amount of money, property, labor, or services obtained by the unauthorized user before notification to the Company.
- c. The Customer must give the Company written notice that unauthorized use of a Credit Card has occurred or may occur as a result of loss, theft or other reasons. For the purposes of this section, "notice" occurs when the Company receives a written confirmation that unauthorized use of a Credit Card has occurred or may occur as a result of loss, theft or other reasons.

SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

A. <u>Description</u>

1. <u>General</u>

InterLATA toll calling service enables a customer to make calls to a calling area not within the same LATA but within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in accordance with the regulations and schedules of charges as set forth in this section. IntraLATA toll calling service enables a customer to make calls to a different local calling area within the same LATA in accordance with the regulations and schedules of charges as set forth in this section. The toll service charges specified in this section are in payment for all service furnished between the calling and called parties, except as otherwise provided in this tariff.

RCN provides switched inbound and outbound services to residential customers; switched and dedicated inbound and outbound services to business customers; the RCN Calling Card, which is an 800 access calling card; and directory assistance for presubscribed customers.

2. <u>Plan A</u>

Plan A is a switched residential calling service. This service is not time of day or mileage sensitive and is billed in full minute increments. In addition to the base per minute rate, customers with Plan A service may designate any two domestic phone numbers and all calls made to the two designated numbers will be charged at a discounted rate.

3. <u>Plan B</u>

Plan B is a switched residential calling service. This service is time of day, but not mileage sensitive with different rates for Day, Evening, and Night/Weekend calling. Calls are billed in full minute increments. Customers choosing Plan B will receive usage based discounts. For any given billing period, customers with a minimum of ten dollars (\$10) up to twenty-five dollars (\$25) in long distance calling will receive a ten percent (10%) discount off their total long distance charges. Also, for any given billing period, customers with a minimum of twenty-five dollars (\$25) in long distance calling will receive a twenty-five dollars (\$25) in long distance calling will receive a twenty-five dollars (\$25) in long distance calling will receive a twenty-five percent (25%) off their total long distance charges.

4. Unity

Unity is a switched outbound and/or inbound service for commercial customers located in On-Net territories. Unity Service is not time of day or mileage sensitive. Calls are billed in initial eighteen (18) second increments and additional six (6) second increments. A minimum one-year term commitment is required to qualify for Unity Service. Unity customers may choose a Monthly Usage Guarantee (MUG) of five hundred dollars (\$500) which will qualify the customer for a five percent (5%) discount off their total monthly outbound billed usage. In the event that a customer with a five hundred dollar (\$500) MUG does not meet the guaranteed level, that customer will be billed the agreed MUG amount.

5. <u>National Advantage 7</u>

National Advantage 7 is a switched outbound and/or inbound service for commercial customers located in Off-Net territories. National Advantage 7 Service is not time of day or mileage sensitive. Calls are billed in initial eighteen (18) second increments and additional six (6) second increments. A minimum one-year term commitment is required to qualify for National Advantage 7 Service.

6. <u>RCN Calling Card</u>

The RCN Calling Card is an 800 access calling card. This service is not time of day or mileage sensitive. The RCN Calling Card for residential users is billed in initial thirty (30) second increments and additional six (6) second increments. Commercial customers are billed in initial eighteen (18) second increments and additional six (6) second increments.

7. Dial Station

Dial Station service is where the person originating the call from other than a public or semi-public telephone dials the telephone number desired and the call is completed without the assistance of a Company operator, except: when an operator records the originating telephone number where no automatic recording equipment is available; when an operator reaches the called telephone number where facilities are not available for dial completion; when an operator places a call for a calling party who identifies himself/ herself as being handicapped and unable to dial the call because of this handicap; and when an operator re-establishes a call which has been interrupted after the called number has been reached.

 - 8. Customer Dialed Classes of Service
 - a. Collect or Bill to Third Number Service applies to calls dialed by the customer and billed to the called party or to a third number with operator assistance.
 - b. Collect or Bill to Third Number Mechanized Service rates apply to a call which is dialed by the customer and billed to the called party or to a third number through interaction with a mechanized system.
 - c. Person-to-person service is where the person originating the call specifies to the operator a particular person, mobile unit, station, department, or office to be reached. Once a call has been established by agreement of the party originating the call, whether the originating party talks with the requested party or another party, the classification of the call remains person-to-person.
 - 9. Operator Dialed Classes of Service
 - a. Collect or Bill to Third Number Service rates apply to a call which is dialed by the operator and billed to the called party or to a third number. However, this class of service does not apply for the operator services specified in Part A.2.a above, when used with customer dialed collect or bill to third number service.
 - b. Person-to-Person Service rates apply to a call dialed by the operator where the person originating the call specifies to the operator a particular person to be reached, a particular mobile station to be reached through a miscellaneous common carrier operator, or a particular station, department or office to be reached through a PBX attendant.

Calls are not time of day sensitive and are billed in full minute increments. There is no monthly recurring line charge with the Bundled Plan.

11. RCN 9.9 Cent Long Distance Stand Alone

RCN 9.9 Cent Long Distance Stand Alone Plan is available to residential customers who subscribe to RCN Long Distance **T** Service. Calls are not time of day sensitive and are billed in full minute increments. Monthly recurring charge is as follows:

12. RCN 9.9 Cent Intralata Toll Bundled Plan

RCN 9.9 Cent Intralata Toll Bundled Plan is available to residential customers who subscribe to RCN Intralata Toll Service and at least one of the following: RCN Local, RCN Internet, RCN Cable* and RCN Cable Modem*. Calls are not time of day sensitive and are billed in full minute increments. There is no monthly recurring line charge with the Bundled Plan.

13. RCN 9.9 Cent Intralata Toll Stand Alone

RCN 9.9 Cent Intralata Toll Stand Alone Plan is available to residential customers who subscribe to RCN Intralata Toll Service. Calls are not time of day sensitive and are billed in full minute increments. Monthly recurring charge is as follows:

B. <u>Billing of Messages</u>

- 1. <u>Collection of Charges</u>
 - a. Charges for all classes of toll calling service are billed against or collected from the calling telephone billed number in all cases, except as noted below.
 - Charges may be billed against or collected from the called telephone if the charges are accepted at the called station (ie., "collect call"). Collect calls cannot be accepted at coin phones or customer owned coin telephones ("COCOTS").
 - (2) Charges may be billed to an authorized telephone as determined by the Company, other than the telephone originating the call or the telephone where the call is terminated (ie., charges are billed to a third number). The transfer of charges to coin phones or COCOTS will not be accepted.
 - b. On all Operator Station messages, chargeable time begins when connection is established between the calling station and the called station, miscellaneous common carrier mobile radio system or PBX.
 - c. On Person-to-Person messages, chargeable time begins when connection is established between the calling person and the particular person or station specified or an agreed upon alternate.
 - d. If the calculation for the charge results in an a fractional charge, the fraction or amount will be rounded down to the nearest whole cent.

 - 1. <u>Usage or Mileage Charges</u>

Usage charges for all mileage sensitive products are based on the airline distance between rate centers associated with the originating and terminating points of the call. RCN uses the rate centers, associated vertical and horizontal coordinates, and method of computing mileage set forth in Bell Atlantic Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

- 2. <u>Time Periods</u>
 - a. Day Rates apply Monday through Friday from 8am to, but not including 5pm.

A. <u>General</u>

- 1. The rate centers and central offices in this Tariff are arranged alphabetically by rate center in the table Rate Guide following.
- 2. The columns headed "V" and "H" contain the vertical and horizontal coordinates for each rate center.
- For the purpose of determining airline mileages vertical and 3. horizontal grid lines have been established across the State of Pennsylvania. The spacing between adjacent vertical grid lines and between horizontal grid lines represents a distance of one coordinate unit. This unit is the square root of 0.1, expressed in statute miles. A vertical (V) and a horizontal (H) coordinate is computed for each rate center from its latitude and longitude local by use of appropriate map-projection equations. A pair of V-H coordinates locates a rate center, for determining airline mileages, at a particular intersection of an established vertical grid line with an established horizontal grid lines. The distance between any two rate centers is the airline mileage computed between their respective coordinate intersections, as explained in 5.2.1 and 5.2.2 following.
- 4. For message toll telephone service and for channels the rate center for a point not listed in this Tariff is the rate center of the central office through which exchange telephone service at the point is furnished.
